- 1.1 both Amphoe have "positive" capabilities but local people still think that performing administrative tasks is "sluggish".
- 1.2 both Amphoes have "positive" in ability of self-adjustments, in flexibility and in conflicts but local people are not adequately informed about the government policy and relating laws.
- 2. In the aspect of influencing factors, the study finds that characteristics of organization, characteristics of personnels, characteristics of office environments and policies and practices of civil administration have the tendency to be "positive". Nevertheless, it is found that political and socio-economic situations have impairing effects on the morale of local officials.
- 3. There are no differences in work performance between Amphoe Muang and Amphoe Ban Hong.

The study's recommendations are:

- 1. works in civil services should be separated from works in order to have clear responsibility.
- 2. new technologies should be applied to the works of civil registration and identity cards
- 3. Amphoe's officials should try to increase the levels of political participation of their local people.
