ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to investigate a plan for the retirement life of the primary school teachers in the provinces of the highest and lowest per capita income the population consisted of 107 teachers of Primary Education Office who will be retired in 1992 and 1993 fiscal years.

The questionnaires concerning a plan for retirement life about economic, health, housing, activities and hobbies, and population were administered. Percentage and X^2 -test were used for data analysis.

It was found that there was no relationship of a plan for the retirement life of the primary school teachers and provinces of the highest and lowest per capita income at the level 0.05 and most subjects with sex, marital status, education, position, family member and income had a close characteristic of a plan for retirement life in economic, health, housing, activities and hobbies, and population.
