The objective of the study is to find the level of cooperation of crime prevention through discrimination of personal backgrounds the residents. The data are gathered by questionnaires

interview schedules from 500 residents in 10 concentrate communities in Bangkok Metropolis. The results of the study are summarized as follows:

The majority of the samples tend to be interested in crime

- prevention in the communities

 - 2. The males tend to be interested more than the females.
 - The older tend to be interested more than the younger. The ones with higher education level tend to be interested

- 5. The ones in the governmental service tend to be interested more than the ones in any other occupation.
- 6. The ones who are married tend to be interested more than the ones who are singles.
- 7. The ones with more familial members tend to be interested more than the one less.
- 8. The ones who resided longer in the community tend to be interested more than the shorter.
- 9. The ones who had some persons at home all the time tend to be interested more than the ones without someone at home all the time.

Recommendations:

- 1. There should be programs of distribution of knowledge in appropriate crime prevention and cooperation among the community members and/or governmental authorities.
- 2. There should be training programs for the police for cooper ation with the community members for information of crime prevention
- 3. The authorized persons should use various sources of media to distribute the crime information in the community and to prevent the crime.
