ABSTRACT

The main objective of this thesis is concentrate to study tambol council role participation on small scale water resources development project in Kalasin province and study the relevance factors in tambol council's participation in order to point out the problems and issues which caused participation activities.

Research Methodology is based on questionnaire to sample size 411 Tumbol council members by select 2 Tumbol council in each districts of Kalasin province.

The results of the study showed that, the sample size participated in medium range on small scale water resources

development about 28 points from 50 fullpoints regard on relevance factors which was influenced by Tumbol council members, whom ultimately conduct many roles of Tumbol Council or Village Community the Utilication project do stimulated the participation in 0.001 significant statistic level.

Furthermore, Training program on water resources and TC's occupation are relevance on career of tambol council members which effected the participation role of tumbol council in small scale water resources development project at 0.01 and 0.05 significant statistic level. in sequence.

Comments

- 1. Election tambol council members do take less responsibility and participation, therefore in order to strenghten tambol council role and expansion study to another provinces to find another different points of views. It should be emphasis on efficiency of Tumbol Council's role.
- 2. Transfer technology and know now on water resource should be concentrate to Tumbol council.
- 3. NorthEastern region should be allocated more budget on small scale water resources.
- 4. Public and private sector should take more action in promotion on water resources to village in remote area.
