ABSTRACT

The purpose of this research was to study the factors related to decision on Further Studying at Bachelor Administration Program in Computer Science of Diploma Students in Business Computing second year of the Bangkok Vocational Students. The subjects 559 were proportional stratified randomly selected from 780 second year, diploma level students in the academic year 2000. The research instrument was a questionnaire of Factors Related to Decision on Further Studying at Bachelor Administration Program in Computer Science, consisted of 4 parts: the first part was general information of the students, the second part was students' family background, the third part was the instructors' environment and the students' expectation while the fourth part was the students' opinion towards continuing Bachelor degree. The data were analyzed by Percentage (%), arithmetic means (\bar{X}), standard deviation (SD) and chi-square (χ^2).

The research results indicated that significant factors related to the students' decision on their further study at .01 were : students' intention to continue further study. Factors found to be significant at .05 was parent's living status and mother's education.
