#### ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research are to study the opinions of the courts and probation officers on the selection of adult probationers and the social data of defendants for probation.

The samples of this research are 68 judges from the Criminal Court, Thonburi Criminal Court, North of Bangkok Magistrate Court, South of Bangkok Magistrate Court and Thonburi Magistrate Court and 74 Probation officers of the Central Probation office the total is 142 cases. The data are collected by means of questionnaires

The research results are as folloow.

1. The Courts and Probation officers have significant differences in the opinions of the selection for adult probationer criteria

2. The sequence of important social data are as follow:

Defender's requirement, Cause for reduction of Punishment, Physical health, Occupation, Condition of mind, Environment, Nature of the offense, Habit, Education and training, Self-Rehability, Intelligent, Age, Historical Background, other conducts.
