



2. The police significantly have disagreement on the participation of private lawyers in the entire process of criminal investigation more than other groups of samples.

3. The private lawyers are more agreeable to the principle of the participation of private lawyers in criminal investigation than the other groups statistically significantly, and, the public prosecutors have the most agreement on the participation of the accused's relatives.

4. The private lawyers agree the most, among all groups, to the principles of the regulation, of the participation of private lawyers in criminal investigation, in the laws of Thailand, for every criminal case assigned to the imprisonment 3 years and over.

5. The police have the most agreement on that, the participation of private lawyers in criminal investigation would result in the red-tape of investigation and disadvantage, and, that the lawyers usually suggest the refusal for the accused despite the accused actually committed the crimes.

6. The public prosecutors agree to the participation of the administrative agents in criminal investigation in case of the absence of the private lawyers, more than the other groups.
