Data collections were done by asking subjects to complete

Gordon Personal Profile - Inventory which was designed by Leonard V.

Gordon. This Inventory can measure 8 personality scales: Ascendancy, Responsibility, Emotional Stability, Sociability, Cautiousness, Original

Thinking, Personal Relations and Vigor. The sum of Ascendancy, Re-

sponsibility, Emotional Stability and Sociability could measure Self Esteem. The reliability of this inventory was 0.54 - 0.89.

The result of this study suggested that psychiatric patients had significantly different personality scores from normal people at statistical level of .05 except Original Thinking scale which showed that there

were not significanly different between two groups at the statistical

level of .05. However the result showed tendency to suggest that the

mean score of psychiatric patients were lower than normal people.
