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ABSTRACT

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This research was conducted with the purpose of constructing moldetermining quality of Moh-Lum cassette on "Forest" aimed at inseminating knowledge of environment among the out of School youth

in the Northeast Region. It was based on the followin procedure :

1. Evaluations of the quality of the cassette on "Forest" with particular respect to its contents, sound, appropriateness of time allocated for listening and characteristics of lyrics.

2. Testing quality of the cassette on "Forest" by comparisons of marks obtained from the pretest and posttest doned by out of school youth in the Northeast.

In proceeding the research, the cassette of Moh-Lum on natural environment which embraced 5 verses was produced. Thereafter, efforts were made to primarily examine the quality of tools with the out of school youth in Rai Noi Sub-District, Muang District, Ubol Ratchathani Province. After the quality of tools met an acceptable standard,

they were employed for experiment with 2 groups of the out of school youth randomly drawn from Nong Sang Sub-District, Ban Phai District, Nonkaen Province and Dong Mayang Sub-District, Amnaj Chareon District, Non Ratchathani Province, which represented the youth in the Northern searn and the Southern Esarn respectively.

1. The quality of the cassette on "Forest" showed that its for a state of the good level and the cassette could disseminate in the Northeast.

The experimental results were as follows:

2. Regarding analysis of the efficiency of cassette on

"Forest" based on comparisons of marks the youth obained from the pretest and posttest it appeared that the marks obtained from the

posttest was signifficantly higher than that from the pretest at the .Of

level. This result showed that out-of-school youth in the Northeast

actually gained their knowledge on forest from the Moh-Lum cassette.
