ABSTRACT

The objectives of this research were to study the knowledges and opinions of sub-district (Tambol) health officers concerning legal measurements for consumer protection of food in Ratchaburi Province according to age, sex, education, experience, additional knowledge, training and information tracing. A total of 324 sub-district (Tambol) health officers, selected from every health center, responded by mail questionnaire. There was a 80.59 percent response rate and of completed questionnaires were analysed by the SPSS/PC* program.

The results of the analysis indicated that the knowledge of sub-district (Tambol) health officers were within moderate levels

opinions were found to be at high levels. Their knowledge was found to differ according to experience, additional knowledge, training and information tracing at the 0.05 significance level. However, only opinions toward information tracing and training were found to be significantly different.

It was recommended, from the study, that the Foods and Drugs Administration (FDA.) provide more knowledge on the legal measurement of food for consumer protection to sub-district (Tambol) health officers through various means such as by newsletter, handbook and training. Also, special consideration should be given to made the improvement of the legal measurement of food.
