The purpose of this descriptive research was to study factors affecting health promotion behaviors relating to food consumption of hospital personnel in Fort Thanarat Hospital. The sample of this study were 205 hospital personnel in Fort Thanarat Hospital. Data were collected by the questionnaire constructed by the researcher. Data analysis was made by statistical computer package for percentage, mean, standard deviation, Chi-square test and Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient.

The research results were as follows.

1. Health promotion behaviors relating to food consumption of hospital personnel in Fort Thanarat Hospital were at the good level.
2. The biosocial factors namely family income had relationship with health promotion behaviors relating to food consumption of hospital personnel in Fort Thanarat Hospital at a statistical significance level of .01
3. The predisposing factors namely food consumption value had relationship with health promotion behaviors relating to food consumption of hospital personnel in Fort Thanarat Hospital at a statistical significance level of .05
4. The enabling factors namely the convenience of self – cooking facilities had relationship with health promotion behaviors relating to food consumption of hospital personnel in Fort Thanarat Hospital at a statistical significance level of .01
5. The reinforcing factors had no significant association with health promotion behavior relating to food consumption.
