Abstract

The study on "Problems and difficulties of investigators in judicial procedures" has the main objective in learning about the prevailing problems and difficulties in the execution of duty of police investigation officers, of public prosecutors and of penitentiary officers. The study also intends of locate the problems and to recommend appropriate measures to alleviate these problems and difficulties.

The methodology of this study is based on judicial documentary research and on data which derive from interviews of state officials who are responsible in different stage of judicial procedures, such as police officers, judges, penitentiary officers and lawyers.

The results of the study indicate that problems and difficulties in judicial procedures are numerous which can be summarized as follows:

- 1. In the aspect of investigation management system, the major problems are the problems in collecting evidences and in administration system of Police Department.
- 2. In the aspect of administration system of Department of Public Prosecution, the major problems are: the problem of giving objections by state prosecutors and of unsynchronized regulations.

3. In the aspect of Thai court's administration system, the problems are: problem in being witnesss, in giving testimony before cuort, in requesting court's warrant of detention and of release, in requesting transcription of court's verdicts and in requesting the payment of ransom.

4. In the aspect of penitentiary administration system, the problems

are: the problem of co-ordination between concerned state agencies while the
