ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research were: to study leadership, effectiveness and relation between the leadership and the effectiveness of the organization of the forensic science work in the northeast.

The sample consisted of 216 operational level of the policemen in the forensic science work in the northeast. The questionnaires were sent to 216 policemen and 210 questionnaires, accounted for 97.2 percent, were returned.

The earned data acquire percentage, means, Chi-square and Contingency coefficient.

Research Results:

- 1. The commanders of the organization of forensic science work in the northeast were mostly consultative leadership.
- 2. The effectiveness of the organization of forensic science work in the northeast was in the moderate level

- 3. The leadership was related to the effectiveness of the organization of forensic science work in the northeast which was statistically significant. ($P \le .05$)
- 4. The consultative and participative leadership were more effective than exploitative authoritative and benevolent authoritative leadership.
