## **ABSTRACT**

purposes of this research were to study 1) the level of leadership of administrators of the secondary schools in Educational Region 5 2) the level of leadership of administrators of the private service business in Educational Region 5 and 3) to comparative the leadership of administrators of the secondary schools and the private service businesses in Educational Region 5. The samples consisted of 24 large secondary schools and 24 large hotels of the private service business in Educational Region 5. Respondents were 24 administrators of the secondary schools, 23 manager of the hotels, 287 teachers and 300 members of the hotels. Questionnaires, adapted by Wera Kengthong, which based on four factors of quality leadership Thomas J. Sergiovanni. All data obtained during January to April 1997, were analyzed by using appropriate percentage, mean, F-test. The findings revealed that leadership of administrators of the secondary schools and the private service business in Educational Region 5 were high and the comparative analysis of the overall of the leadership of administrators of the secondary schools and the private service business in Educational Region 5 found significantly different at the .05 levels including prerequisities, perspective, principle, platform, purposing, planning, peopling, and patriotism.
