 Teamwork Behaviors of Secondary schools with Different Levels of

 Academic Performance, Education Region 1.

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ABSTRACT

The purpose of this research was to study the team working's behaviors of secondary schools under the Department of General Education of the Educational Region 1. The objective of the study was to determine 1) the aspects and productivity of team working in high and low academic operational secondary schools and 2) the different aspects and productivity of team working in high and low academic operational secondary schools and 2) the different aspects and productivity of team working in high and low academic operational secondary schools and 2) the different aspects and productivity of team working in high and low academic operational secondary schools. The samples of the study was a group of 19 high and 19 low academic operational secondary schools respectively. The data were collected by a constructed questionnaire from 380 teachers and administrators. The statistic employed in this study were percentage, arithmetic mean, standard deviation , the Mann-Whitney U Test , SPSS/PC⁺ (statistical package for the social science / personal computer plus). The findings of the study were as follows....

The mean of aspects and productivity of the high academic operational schools was also high, considering all of the components, component of team leader, team members and team process was high too, only team structure was moderate and the mean of aspects and productivity of low academic operational schools was moderate, considering all the components but the aspects and productivity of the team working in high and low academic operational schools perceived statistical differences at the .05 level of significance.

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
