

Title : Morale of the Government - Saving Bank's

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It was found from this reasearch :

1. That the majority of the respondents has a tenure of more than 5 years, an education level below a Bachelor's Degree, Salary Scale of more than B 5,000 and been married.
2. That from a macro perspective the majority of the respondents has a high level of morale.
3. That from a micro perspective the majority of the respondents scores a low lever of morale in terms of a sense of belonging and a sense of security and safety.
4. That from a micro perspective the majority of the respondents scores a high level of morale in terms

of a sense of responsibility, a sense of success, a sense of satisfaction towards work, and a sense of interpersonal relationship within the GSB, however.

5. That the respondents who score high from a macro perspective are those who have a tenure of more than 5 years.

6. That the respondents who score high from a micro perspective in terms of a sense of responsibility are those who have an education of below a Bachelor's Degree.

7. That the respondents who score high from a micro perspective in terms of a sense of security and safety are those who have a tenure of 5 years and less and a salary scale of B 5,000 and less.

8. That respondents who score high from a micro perspective in terms of satisfaction towards work are those who are separate from their spouses.

In the end, the researcher calls for a replication of this research project utilizing more independent variables.
