The purposes of this research were 1) to study administration behavior of administrators of the schools attached to Chiangmai municipality and those of the schools attached to the Elementary Education Office in Muang district , Chiangmai province ; and 2) to compare the administration of those administrators. The data were collected by means of 201 questionnaires (100%) and processed by using the SPSS. The statistics used were percentage , average , standard deviation and T-test.

The research results were as follows :

1. The administrators of municipal schools were 44.64 years old on average ; most of them were women , married and had a bachelor degree. Their average working period was 21.29 years.

2. Both types of schools had a high level of administration in the following areas : academic affairs , student affairs , personnel , administrative and financial work , building work and the relation between schools and communities. The municipal schools had higher mean scores , in all aspects, than the schools attached to the Elementary Education Office. The two types of schools were found to be different in academic affairs , personnel , building work and relation between schools and communities but they were not different in student affairs and administrative and financial work. The municipal schools were found to emphasize building work while the schools attached to the Elementary Education Office emphasized administrative and financial work.
