David Miller (tenor, from the USA) says: "So much of what has happened has exceeded our hopes and expectations, and the future seems wide open. But we still have to keep ourselves grounded in the music, in passion for the music, and for performing."

"So we're very proud of the new album, and the vocals we've come up with. We're branching out a little, but it's still the Il Divo sound. We've done Nights In White Satin, and Bryan Adams's Have You Ever Really Loved A Woman? But the whole album has a much more Latin feel, more up-tempo. It's more fun."

Sebastian Izambard (Vox Populi from France) says: "Our adventure has been amazing. Two years ago, I never thought I would travel so much, meet so many people, or work so hard. I couldn't believe it when I heard we would be singing with Barbra Streisand, and it has been fabulous."

Sebastian, the only self-taught singer, is an accomplished songwriter who plays guitar and piano and has produced for many other French artists. "The new album is different from the other two, it's another side of Il Divo, a side we've never shown before. We use Cuban percussion, the melodies are very different. I think it's really great."

Urs Buhler (tenor, from Switzerland) says: "I'm very happy about the third album. Except for Somewhere, which is in English, everything is in Spanish or Italian and it has more rhythm. I think it's very sexy actually! And the songs are wonderful. I really love Without You. The Mariah Carey version is great and the Nilsson original is wonderful, but I am really proud of our version."

Urs, who started singing with a hard rock band, had sung at the Salzburg Festival, was based in Holland, singing with Netherlands Opera. "Life is very exciting, and never better than when we're

on tour. I love the travelling. It has changed my views on the world, stretched my horizons."

Carlos Marin (baritone, from Spain) says: "Now we know each other so well, we only need to watch each other's eyes, and we know what the other guy is thinking, and how he will sing the part. It's an amazing closeness."

"We needed this when we first started to sing with Barbra Streisand, an unbelievable honour. Of course we were nervous, but when she arrived, we couldn't believe that she was this sweet woman who was asking our opinion. She has a beautiful, amazing voice, but she likes to improvise, so at first rehearsal it was a little difficult. But it soon came together, and the mix of our voices is very special."

Carlos, a star of the opera scene was based in Madrid and was renowned for his work in many operas such as La Traviata and La Boheme. "In my opinion, this album is the best of the three. The original songs are better, the vocal arrangements are more precise, more elaborate. And of course, it's still always romantic. How could it not be?"

"We just want to grow and grow. We do our best, try every single day to improve ourselves. Even my English is improving! Now when I go back to Spain, I sometimes find I am thinking in English, and English words come out with the Spanish."

David has the final word: "We are built for singing, that's what we're here for, to let our voices out, and let the music ring. Now we're going to the next step."

Il Divo is giving two concerts in Finland: on June 4th at Turkuhalli in Turku and on June 5th at the Hartwall Areena in Helsinki.

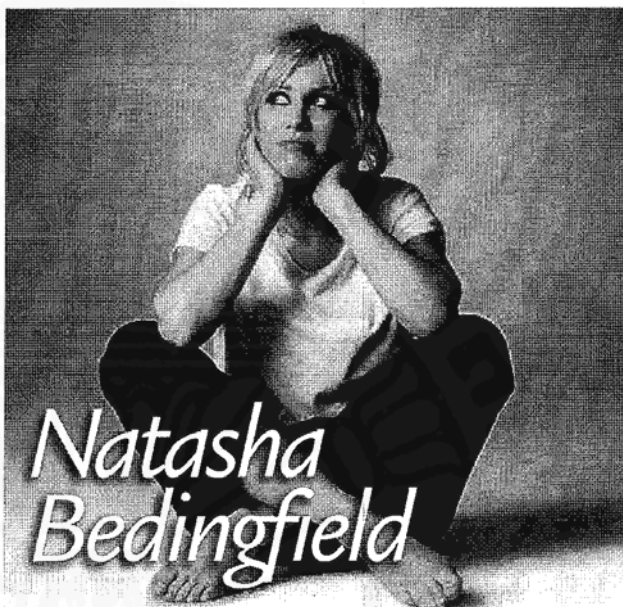
With a number one single in America, over six million units shifted worldwide, Natasha Bedingfield is the UK's biggest female pop star bar none, a bold, beautiful home grown answer to US uber divas Christina and Pink.

Natasha took the US by storm last year with the first British chart topping hit by a female in almost twenty years. 'Vanity Fair' singled her out as the spearhead of a new Britpop invasion; she became one of the faces of Gap (alongside Mia Farrow and Common); she jammed with her hero Prince at a private party; Bono enlisted her in his (RED) campaign; and her song 'Unwritten' proved to be the most played song on mainstream American radio last year.

Taken from her forthcoming album, 'N.B.' the single is a playful yet pointed representation of Natasha's shifting priorities. "I want to make music that matches who I am. My first album was about independence and opportunism. I'm still very independent and I find it hard to let go of that freedom, but I'm in a different place now. I've been dating, searching for a partner, looking for Mr Right et cetera... This album reflects that."

Recorded in Los Angeles, Natasha has co-written and co-produced the album, working with a stellar team of talent including Mike Elizondo of Eminem/Dre/50 Cent fame, Adam Levine, Greg Kirsten (Beck, Lily Allen) and previous collaborators (Steve Kipner, Andrew Frampton, Wayne Wilkins, Danielle Brisebois and Wayne Rodrigues), and long time Madonna collaborator Pat Leonard. "I lived right by the beach where I was working, so I could head straight into the studio every morning. The way I write is I brainstorm and jam it out, and it helps to have everything set up to capture the moment."

With over a (1.4) million downloads of her single, 'Unwritten', Natasha became the first British female to score a no. 1 in the US billboard pop chart since Kim Wilde and 'You Keep Me Hangin' On', 19 years earlier. "I got to experience the American dream, the concept that you start out as a nobody and make yourself into someone. It was humbling, but freeing as well and I found that's quite a good place from which to write." Never one to mouth empty platitudes, Natasha



has a gift for creating pop music that does not sacrifice intelligence on the altar of universal appeal. "I love music that has thought put into it, and is not just formulaic. I hope that when someone listens to my songs they will discover a few different layers. At the same time, I want to communicate, and I don't want to put up barriers. It is pop because it's not elitist, it's anthemic, it's got structure to it and it's easy to understand. Plus, I like to dance. I love lots of weird experimental music and sensitive singer-songwriters, but they are kind of hard to shake your arse to." Emotionally, she says, the new album represents a kind of "surrender". "That is probably a big part of what happened to me this past year, discovering the limitations of being human - a woman with feelings and emotions in a male dominated business. I pushed myself so hard in America. I was exhausted afterwards, and that makes you question your values, and see the fragility of life. I always felt life really was "unwritten" - a blank page and you can make of it whatever you want, but I started to understand you can't just be a positive thinker and expect the whole world to come falling at your feet."

One of the key songs on the new album, for Natasha, is 'Soulmate', a searching ballad on which she asks "Somebody tell me why I'm on my own / If there's a soul mate for everyone?" "My par-

ents do counselling and social work, and growing up, I've seen all these people whose relationships fall apart, and I know the reasons why it's so complicated, it's like I already know too much! I know enough to be scared of commitment! Even once you find that person, there's no perfect happy ending. But if you were so scared of bad things happening to you then you'd never do anything, or have any fun, and nothing would work! So all you can do is surrender."

One new song, in particular, sums up her attitude. It's called 'Pirate Bones'. "It's partly about fame. Everyone knows who you are and that's lovely, but what about when you want to have private time by yourself? Everyone still knows who you are, and you walk around in the hat and glasses to try and hide. It's actually quite a big thing to give up your anonymity and there has to be a reason to give it up. You better enjoy it, and have a sense of purpose. If you're giving up your enjoyment of life for somebody else's idea of success, it's like being a pirate who's got his hoard of treasure and is sitting on an island where there are no shops to spend it. It doesn't mean anything."

The album "N.B." will be released on June 6th.

The music of *Blood Mountain* isn't all that separates Mastodon from the hordes of trendy metal bands. The lyrics are also pretty out there. Like Mastodon's remarkable 2004 record *Leviathan* – which earned Album of the Year honors in *Revolver*, – *Blood Mountain* is a brain-teasing concept album. But while *Leviathan* was based on Herman Melville's 1851 novel "Moby Dick," Mastodon hatched the multi-tiered plot for the new album out of their own demented minds. The disc tells the story of a quest to ascend *Blood Mountain* to find a crystal skull, reach the top and insert the skull inside the band members' own heads in order to eradicate "reptile brain" and transport them to the next phase of human evolution. Of course, the trek is far from simple.

Psychedelic imagery notwithstanding, *Blood Mountain* is ultimately a metaphor for the obstacles and triumphs Mastodon have encountered since they began their musical crusade. The band formed in 1999 shortly after ex-Lethargy and ex-Today is the Day members Dailor (drums) and Bill Kelliher (guitar) moved from Rochester, New York to Atlanta. One night, during a High on Fire show, the two met ex-Four Hour Fogger bassist Sanders and guitarist Hinds and started talking underground metal.

"We were all familiar with each other's histories," says Sanders, "because we were fans of Today is the Day. And Bill had seen our band play opening for Neurosis when he was visiting Atlanta in '98. They said they needed a second guitar player and a bass player to form this new band, and we were like, 'Well, hey, dude, here we are. Hell, yeah.' Two or three days later,

we were down in the practice space making a racket just to see if the vibe would gel, and within five minutes it felt like a done deal."

After playing Ozzfest last year, Mastodon started working on songs for *Blood Mountain*. They wrote tirelessly for five and a half weeks, about two weeks longer than they had to write *Leviathan*. The extra time gave them the luxury to demo the songs before they recorded them – something they'd never had the chance to do – as well as experiment with different techniques that give the songs extra flavor and texture. "Circle Cysquatch" features a harrowing vocoder voiceover, "Bladecatcher" includes squelching vocals that sound like an angry R2D2 and "Crystal Skull" opens with tinny tribal clatter before thundering into the opening riff.

Mastodon recorded the album with Bayles from the middle of February until the beginning of April. Again, it was more time than they'd ever had, but this time there were the added pressures of living up to their own legacy, and it never felt like there was enough hours in the day.

"We sat and listened to everything at the end of every day and talked about how the songs were coming along and what we wanted to change," Sanders says. "After a while, I kind of felt like the world was on our shoulders. We just wanted to make the coolest music possible and make sure it was as awesome as it could be – make sure every riff, every note, every drumbeat was in the perfect spot."

In the end, Mastodon crafted an album that's

musically sophisticated yet primal, a disc where every new passage, regardless of how slow or fast, leads to the culmination of an epic adventure. And the diversity is astonishing. "Capitularian Crest" alternates between jazzy tendrils and moshpit-rattling ferocity, sounding like a fierce amalgam of Motorhead, King Crimson and Rush. "Hunters of the Sky" is a surging, off-kilter race with drums as tumultuous as Keith Moon and "Pendulous Skin" is a expansive and celestial, with guitars reminiscent at times of Deep Purple and Pink Floyd.

"I really wanted to do guitar cartwheels and finger gymnastics on this record," says Hinds. "There are more solos on this than any other Mastodon album, but every part, no matter how complex, is there for a reason. We just really went for it more than we've ever done."

In addition to challenging instrumental passages, *Blood Mountain* features vocals that range from melodic conversations to raging diatribes. "We're all smart enough to know that we don't have to scream our brains out every second for the whole album," Sanders explains. "That's just not where we want to go as we expand and further our catalog of music. Overall, there was just more room and more potential for various vocal sounds on this album. And we're not at all apprehensive about doing it because we don't feel like we're cheating out or doing anything wrong."

With the release of *Blood Mountain*, Mastodon have reached the top of a peak, from which they can see other, even higher mountains before them. And that's where they're headed next. Regardless of how many cover stories or awards they receive, Mastodon are driven by the need to ascend the mountain, implant the skull and ascend to the next level of evolution. It's not that they're unappreciative of the accolades, they're just too busy focusing on the next project to stop what they're doing.

"When we started, we never imagined getting to where we are today," Sanders says. "We're so grateful and we appreciate everything that's been said about us. This has all been unreal. I never thought we'd do major tour support for Iron Maiden in Europe or be on a major label or be on our fourth tour with Slayer, or be ranked as having one of the Top 10 albums of the year in any magazine. It's all been part of this crazy journey that we've lived, and we'll keep rolling forward. We feel like we've still got so far left to go."
