ABSTRACT

At pressent a total of more than 400,000 rai of mined-land throughout the country. This mined-land considered to be underutilized and has furtherly caused negative impact particularty to the water resource in term of soil erosion. The under utilization of land and the negative impact reflect not only the great loss of benefit from land but also mistakes in the policy of mineral resources utilization management in past. Thus, to eradicate the cause of these problesm at grass-root, analyitcal study shold be carried out to formalate the mined-land policy development, which is the main objective of this study. The result of this sutudy will be employed to set up the appropriate and to cast the light on the profit maximization of the limited natural resource. This study based its principles on guuidelines and methods of 4 experts in policy analysis and 2 experts in law. The study is carried out step-wise.... at the initial step, relevant facts and policies exixted in the law concerning the mained-land has been drawn out, studied and analyzed. At the interim step.... evalution of these policies and eventually the results of the evalation are summed up and applied to improve and develop the policy.

From the results of this study, mined-land policy has been developed and, thus, proposed as follows;

1. National level government agency should be set up to under go the analytical stuudy which leads to the formation of mineral resource utilization policy.

2. Government agency to oversee the impact caused by mining industry should be extablished seperately from the one that is responsible for mineral resource management.

3. Standardized quality of environment should be explicitly set cover both mined-land and their adjacent areas.

4. Mined-land should be declared as area under specific
ontrol and another goverment agency should be take case of these area.
5. Models and methods of mined-land utilization shold be
oplicitly added as the conditions in the mining permit lease.

Recommendations mentioned above, are guidelines to improve and evelop the mined-land above all. These guidelines need to be put onth as the legalized criterial thus, to effectively solve the problem caused by mined-land.... otherwise to no wail.
