The Development of Norms for the 16 PF

(Form A) in High School Students in

Bangkok

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ABSTRACT

The Purposes of the study were to develop age norms of high

school students in Bangkok for the Sixteen Personality Factors questionnaire (Form A) and to compare the differences of sixteen-personality factors between male and female high school students.

Nine hundred and eighty - nine high school students were 431 males and 558 females, ages 15 to 17 were drawn form wat sungwej school, Bhudhajuk vitthaya school, Houwang school, Kunnatee ruttharam school, Thepleela school, Chinoros vithayalai school Bangpakok vithayakom and Wat Pradunaisongtham school. The development of norms were obtained by sten score technique and the differences between male and female personality factors were compared by t - test.

The results were as follow:

- 1. The male, female and total norms of the 16 PF (Form A) for high school students in Bangkok were developed with 431, 558 and 989 sample size, respectively.
- 2. The differences of personality factors between males and females were found in these factors.
 - 2.1 Factor A: Reserved Outgoing
 - 2.2 Factor B: Low Intelligence High Intelligence
 - 2.3 Factor C: Emptionally Instability Emotionally stable
 - 2.4 Factor I: Tough Minded Tender Minded
 - 2.5 Factor M: Practical Imaginative
 - 2.6 Factor N : Genuine and Forthright Astute and Shrewd
 - 2.7 Factor Q3: Undisciplined Self Conflict Controlled
 - 2.8 Factor Q4 :ReTaxed Tense
 - 2.9 Faking good and faking bad scale (FG, FB)
