

Abstract

The study was aimed to determine sex need, sexual relation and abnormal symptom during postpartum period among married women. The subjects were 400 married women who returned to postpartum clinic at Mother and Child hospital, Health Promotion Centre Region 5, Nakornrajseema province.

The result of the study were that, 13.25 percents of cases had sex need during postpartum period, most of them had in the fourth week. Almost 30 percents had sexual relationship and the earliest time was the second week after delivery. The majority had in the fourth week and the minimum of the coital frequency during postpartum period was only one time. After they had sexual relationship, they feel orgasm as before they became pregnant. Few of them had abnormal symptom, and the majority had paraunia.
