ABSTRACT

The purpose of this research was to study the

factors effected the duty of investigation and crime apprehension of the commissioned police ranked inspector in the police station under the local police command unit within the regional headquarters 6. The total of 361 questionnaires were used to gather all data. The target population were chief inspectors, prevention and suppression inspectors, investigation inspectors, detective inspectors, vice-prevention and suppression inspectors, vice-investigation inspectors, vice-detective inspectors. All of the questionnaires were recieved. The data were analized by computer program SPSS-X which described the percentage, arithmetic mean and standard deviation.

Findings:

- 1. The opinions of the commissioned police officers on the factors affecting the investigation and achievement of the police officers at the "high" level were high experience of the investigetors, good leadership of the commanders, prosperous chance on duty and an investigation training.
- 2. The opinion of the commissioned police officers at the "moderate" level were applying police science, people's coorperation and commanders supporting.
