

Thesis Title Factors Influencing the Performance of Health
Center Personnel on Tuberculosis Case Finding
in Roi-Et Province

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Abstract

The main objectives of the research were to determine relationships of personal factors, working conditions, hygiene and motivator factors and the performance of health center personnel on tuberculosis case-finding in Roi-Et province, and to identify factors influencing their job performance on tuberculosis case-finding activities. Self administered questionnaires were sent to 192 health center personnel with 89.5 % respondent rate.

The results showed that job performance in case-finding activity fell in low level. There were relationships of position factors, financial support and the performance on tuberculosis case-finding.

Hygiene and motivator factors showed no association with case-finding activity while budget and motivation for achievement were found to be factors could be used to predict the variation of case-finding activity at 9.29 %.

It is recommended that financial and technical support should be increased. In addition, applying primary health care through community participation in case-finding is essential.
