relationships of personal factors, working conditions, hygiene and notivator factors and the performance of health center personnel on tuberculosis case-finding in Roi-Et province, and to identify factors influencing their job performance on tuberculosis case-finding activities. Self administered questionaired were sent to 192 health center personnel with 89.5% respondent rate.

The main objectives of the research were to determine.

The results showed that job performance in case-finding activity fell in low level. There were relationships of position factors, financial support and the performance on tuberculosis casefinding.

Hygiene and motivator factors showed no association with caseanding activity while budget and motivation for achievement were cound to be factors could be used to predict the variation of caseanding activity at 9.29 %:

It is recommended that financial and technical support will be increased. In addition, applying primary health care through

ommunity participation in case-finding is essential.
