The purpose of this research was to study the level of people participation in crime prevention as well as the factors resulting to people's participation in crime prevention. The sample size consisted of 391 family heads in communities/villages in the area of Sumrongnua Provincial Police Station. The questionnaires were used in data collecting. Information analysis was made statistically with computer program making in percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test and one-way ANOVA with the level of statistical significant at .05.

The research found out that the level of participation in crime prevention of family heads was at medium to low. The sample group played a more active role in the prevention of crime in an individual and a family level than in a community level. The hypothesis found that the factors resulting to people participation in crime prevention were sex, income, occupation, duration of living in communities, attitudes towards the police staff and their experiences in crime. Age and knowledge about crime prevention were not relevant to participation in crime prevention.
