Guilty Plea Proceeding²

The defendant personally appearing before me, I have ascertained the following facts, nothing each by initialing it.

Judge Initialing

- 1. The defendant understands the nature of the charges against him.
- 2. That the defendant understands the range of possible sentence for the offences charged, from a suspended sentence to a maximum of _____ and that the mandatory minimum(if any) is _____
- 3. That the defendant understands the following constitutional right which he give up by pleading guilty:
 - His right to trial by jury, if any
 - His right to the assistance of an attorney at all stages of the proceeding, and to an appointed attorney, to be furnished free of charge, if he can not afford one.
 - His right to confront the witnesses against him and to crossexamine them as to the truthfulness of their testimony.
 - His right to present evidence on his own behalf and to have the state compels witnesses of his choosing to appear and testify.
 - His right to remain silent and to be presume innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
- 4. That the defendant wishes to give up the constitutional right of wish he has been advised.
- That there exists a basis in fact for believing the defendant guilty of the offence charged.

- 6. That the defendant and the prosecutor have entered into a plea agreement and that the defendant understands and consents to its terms.
- 7. That the plea is voluntary and not the result of force threats or promises other than plea agreement.

On the basis of this findings, I conclude that the defendant knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently pleads guilty to the above charges, and accept his plea.
