

The purpose of this study was to investigate two factors which related to student activities participation undergraduate students in Srinakharinwirot University Prasarnmitr. There were student status and environment. Sampling of the study were Srinakharinwirot Prasarnmitr University's students registered in the second semester of 1992. The subjects were 360. The data were collected by using rating-scale questionnaires. Chi-square test and Crammer's V were applied to data for testing of significant difference and degree of association between variables, t-test and F-test.

The following research findings were drawn from this study:

1. Student status including grade point average, monthly income, works and live place ; statistically related to the desires in student activity.
2. Student's environment towards student activity including student's attitude and experience ; statistically related to the desires in student activity.
3. The two factor yielded a low level of relationships to students' activity.
