

The purposes of this research were as follows: firstly, to study Srinakharinwirot University faculty members' attachment to the institution and their job satisfaction; secondly, to find correlation between the attachment and the job satisfaction of these faculty members'; thirdly, to compare the attachment and the job satisfaction of the faculty members in accordance with their sex, salaries, education, academic ranks and experiences. The sample was comprised of 297 faculty members of all Srinakharinwirot University campuses namely: Prasarnmitr, Patumwan, Bangkhen, Bangsaen, Mahasarakam, Pisanulok, and Songkhla. The 65 items of rating scale questionnaire was employed for data collection. Mean, Standard deviation, Pearson's Product Moment Correlation, t-test and F-test statistics were employed in data analysis.

Major findings were

1. The faculty members' attachment to the institution was at high level while their job satisfaction was at moderate level.
2. The correlation between the job satisfaction and the attachment to the institution was positive and statistically significant at .01 level.
3. The faculty members of different sex, salary, educational degree, academic rank and experience had different levels of attachment and job satisfaction.
