ABSTRACT

This research aims to: 1) study the level of participation of the people in public services of Sub-District Administrative Organization in Sing Buri Province; 2) study the public services of Sub-District Administrative Organization in Sing Buri Province; 3) compare the participation of people in public services of Sub-District Administrative Organization in Sing Buri Province, classified by gender, age, level of education, occupation, and monthly income; 4) study the relationship between the participation of people and public services of Sub-District Administrative Organization in Sing Buri Province. The samples used in this study were 399 electorates in Sing Buri Province. The samples were drawn using Yamane's formula of sample size and stratified random sampling based on the proportion of people in 33 Sub-District Administrative Organizations in Sing Buri Province. The instruments used in the study included questionnaires with the coefficient of reliability at the level of 0.902. The data were analyzed in term of frequency, percentage, mean, standard deviation. t-test, one-way ANOVA, Scheffe's method and Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient.

The results were as follows:

1. The participation of the people in public services of Sub-District Administrative Organization in Sing Buri Province was rated in overall at a moderate level. As a whole, when considering each aspect, the aspect of mutual benefit was rated at the highest level, the aspect of working cooperation at a moderate level, mutual decision making and work evaluation at the lowest level, respectively.

2. The public services of Sub-District Administrative Organization in Sing Buri Province were rated in overall at a moderate level. When considering the aspects of the

public services, it was found that the two aspects including working for a living and public services were rated high, the four aspects including protection and public disaster alleviation, public utility, natural resources, and environment and economy were rated moderately.

3. The level of participation of the people in public services of Sub-District Administrative Organization in Sing Buri Province when classified by gender, age, marital status, was rated differently at a significant level of .05. However, it was found that there were no significant differences when considering at education level, occupation, and monthly income.

4. The relationship between the participation of people and public services of Sub-District Administrative Organization in Sing Buri Province was positively with statistical significance of .01 level, but related at low level ($r = 0.248$)
