ABSTRACT

The study is designed to determine the leadership factors affecting the village development in the two villages of Koarat province, in Thailand, where the development activities are based on the concept of Technical Cooperation Among Developing Villages. It is a comparative study of the village leaders of a successful village Don Yai and a less successful village Non Muang. The study is based on the opinion data of the selected villagers of these two villages. The areas of leaderships factors dealt were the behavioural pattern of the village leaders in technological knowhow, social knowhow and commitments.

The findings of the study was that there is definitely a bearing on the leadership qualities and the success of village developments in TCDVs.
