ABSTRACT

The immediate objective of this study is to examine the relationship between mothers' education, use of health care services, immunization and infant mortality for 24 districts in West Java Province, Indonesia, using secondary data sources. The investigator tries to identify which factors are most closely related to the IMR. Although there are numerous variables relating to infant mortality, this study will focus on mothers' education, immunizable diseases, infant vaccination, birth assistance, use of the PHC and malnutrition.

The ultimate objective of this study is to provide information about the factors which influence IMR in Indonesia which will be of use to policy makers and health care providers.
