ABSTRACT

This study was a hospital-based, descriptive study among 350 mothers of infants 6 months of age or less attending pediatric clinics of the General Hospital of Jambi Province to determine the factors influencing the breast feeding. The method of data collection was questionnaire interviewing by trained personnel.

The data was analyzed by descriptive analysis and stratified analysis. The main variables to be measured were maternal characteristics, infant characteristics, family characteristics and breast feeding characteristics.
