



control agent to reduce emollient effect on hair growth. The results indicated that fresh *Aloe vera* (Linn.) Burm. f. gel can stimulate rat's hair growth better than gel preparation. This probably due to the viscosity of the preparation prevent the penetration through the hair roots. Most of drug applied stucked to the hair. However, in this experiment shaving may effect hair growth. Further study in human is needed to develop aloe vera gel as hair stimulating agent.
