ABSTRACT

This study is aimed to determine the factors influencing the acceptance of tubectomy method of Thai women. There were four hypotheses in this study. The hypotheses stated that the nonacceptance of tubectomy would be determined by : knowledge , attitude , number of children in family , distance between home and location of tubectomy services and family income.

The subjects were 79 married women (15 - 45 years old) who currently use tubectomy method , and 121 married women (15 - 45 years old) who do not use tubectomy method. The results of the study indicate that the using of tubectomy method has been influenced by knowledge , attitude , number of children , and family income, while the distance between home and location of services does not show any significant different between the cases and the control.
