This thesis presents the Description of Pho Karen, a Tibeto-Burman language in Thailand. The thesis includes phonology and syntax of the language, especially of the dialect spoken in Tambon Kan Makrut and Tambon Khok Khwai, Ban Rai District, Uthai Thani Province.

The phonological part consists fo the Stress Group, the Syllable and the Phoneme. The syntactical part consists of word, phrase, clause and sentence levels. The tagmemic approach is used to describe the language.
