



The Purpose of this research was to study the expectation and actual roles of physical education teachers as perceived by school administrators in office of the education ministry, the Church of Christ in Thailand.

The instruments were questionnaires which were constructed by the researcher and validated by 7 experts Cronbach's Alpha coefficient correlation was used to find out the reliability. The data were analyzed in terms of percentage, mean and standard deviation.

The results were as follows:

The expectation of physical education teachers as perceived by school administrators in office of the education ministry, the Church of Christ in Thailand were at highest level and the actual roles of physical education teachers as perceived by school administrators in office of the education ministry, the Church of Christ in Thailand were high level in every aspects.
