This study investigates the efficiency of instructional packages for teaching group singing at prathomsuksa 5 level.

The subjects in the study were 41 students in prathomsuksa 5 from Yala Kindergarten School. The study was conducted in the first semester of 1999 academic year, using a quasi-experimental design. The experiment was conducted within 18 periods of teaching with 20 minutes in each period. The instruments used to collect data were progressive tests, posttests students' portfolio and singing performance tests. These results were analyzed to find the percentage and ratio between formative and summative evaluations on both theoretical and practical achievement scores.

The results of the study revealed that the package had higher efficiency than the expected criteria of 80/80. The subjects obtained progressive scores of 86.24 percent for theoretical content and 84.43 percent for the practical content. Learning outcomes measured by post or summative tests were 81.95 percent for theoretical content and 95.12 percent for practical content. In conclusions the instructional package demonstrated efficiency as expected in the criteria.
