The purpose of this study was to study factors affecting drug disposal in the area under the jurisdiction of Saraburi Provincial Police Region in the opinion of the Narcotics Suppression Police.

The population of the study was 150 Narcotics Suppression Police of Saraburi Provincial Police Region . The data was analysed by percentage, mean , standard deviation and chi-square and the findings of the study are summarized as follow :

1. Most of the subjects are non - commissioned police with average service of 14 years and have been involved with narcotics suppression for 4 years. The average number of arrests is 37.

2. For most of the subjects, factors affecting amphetamine disposal in the area are (1) the slow process of searching permit caused by the Constitution which require that the search warrant be issued by courts. (2) the lack of cooperation from people in terms of investigation and suppression of drug dealers (dealers).

**Recommendations:**

1. There should be a constitutional amendment which will facilitate police officers in performing their task.

2. Allowing of bail for recorded dealers and the reduction of punishment should not be allowed, and confiscation measures should be strictly implemented.
