1. The objectives of the study are to find the needs in investigation training and the problems affecting them. The subjects of the study are 287 Police Cadet Investigation Trainees who are trained in the Metropolitan police stations. The data were collected through questionnaires. The results of the study are summarised as follow:

2. Most of the subjects age from 23 to 25 years old with the average age of 23.61 years. One-fourth of the subjects have girl friends during the training but four-fifths of them indicate that to have a girl friend during investigation training will be an obstacle against the work.

3. The subjects agree with that, they have personal motives to attend the Police Cadet Academy, they satisfy with the result of studying at the Police Cadet Academy,

4. The subjects agree with that, the experience in investigation reporting and the knowledges gained from the academy are not sufficient enough for investigation training .

5. The subjects ask for the Needs as. more experience in investigation report, good care from investigation trainers, task according to rules and orders, less delay investigation report, cooperation from police station staff, cooperation from citizen for investigation, and better coordination between internal and external task units respectively.

The author recommends that the National Police Headquarter would provide the facilities for the investigation and detective task of the police station, for the police station is the first gate of the criminal justice system that can provide justice to both the offenders and the victims. The deprivation of the facilities would result in unjust judgment and illicit acts of the personnel. Nevertheless, as the situation of the national economy like present days, a better way to solve the problem is to provide knowledge to the police personnel to mobilise the activities at their best as the facilities available.
