

## Abstract

This programmed book presented tactics in using context clues to detect the meaning of unfamiliar words. The book begins with an explanation of the term "context", followed by general (simple) words with multimeanings and how to derive the right meaning in a particular context. Next comes a variety of context clues available in sentences, which have been categorized and illustrated with detailed explanation. After each category has been presented, exercises for practice will directly follow. The categories of context clues presented are punctuation; synonyms, restatements and definitions; antonyms and contrast; examples; explaining "How"; explaining "Why"; explaining causes and results; and other miscellaneous clues. The appendices of the book contain supplementary exercises for further practice, pre- and post-test, and keys to answers for exercises in all lessons. The pre- and post-test available will help students to measure their own proficiency before and after studying this self-study book.
