The 51.4 percentages were immigration from other provinces and melted for good the environment in the watershed. The 71.0 percentages were needed the migration but have been repay from government were satisfied. For the output from checked by sharpen questionnaire were 27 person (69. 23 percentages) were needed the migration if the government pay were satisfied. And 12 persons (30.76 percentages) were not migrated from the watershed but might migration if satisfy for state policy about 18.18 percentage and 9.0 percentage immigration if all people in family to encourage.
