The purpose of this survey research is to analyze the problems with the model of subdistrict primary health care supervision in ten districts of Suphanburi province. The sample was 155 supervisors working at health centers and 260 supervisees working at Primary Health Care Community Centers for at least 1 year. Direct interview and questionnaire were used to collect data from subdistrict health personnel and village health volunteers. Percentage, mean, standard deviation, Analysis of Variance, Nonparametric Test with Kruskal-Wallis, One-way ANOVA and Chi-square Test were applied for data analysis.

It is found that the majority of supervisors and supervisees expressed low concern for overall supervision problems, but medium concern for the style, staff, skill and shared-value of health supervision. They were highly agreed with the need for development and support from higher level administrators. The Subdistrict Primary Health Care supervisors and supervisees had medium knowledge and understanding regarding their jobs. It is suggested from the study that a training or meeting be arranged to identify and solve critical problems together as well as to develop specific guidelines for future enhancement.
