

Warapon Jandam 2012: Unwanted Pregnancy of the Students and Protection.

The objectives of this research were to study unwanted pregnancy and protection of students aims 1) to study the attitude towards sexuality of students, 2) to study the factors affecting sexuality that leads to unwanted pregnancies of students and 3) to study protection guidance for unwanted pregnant students.

Using snowball sampling to collect data by participant observation and deep interview with students who have unwanted pregnancies and make their decision on abortion, total is 8 students. The result of this research found that the attitude towards sexuality of sample group incurred from three attitude changes such as acceptance, imitation and don't think about problem occurred. The factors affecting unwanted pregnancies were lack of knowledge, incorrect attitude and belief in birth control, lack of sex knowledge, involuntary sex and rape. When entering into pregnancy, so chose to solve the problem by abortion due to places on abortion access easily.

Protection guidance of unwanted pregnancies is to prevent from occurring pregnancy by learning sexuality education, value clarification and belief about sexuality equally and teaching correct birth control to parents, schools and building value for society of new sexuality changing from not allow to give advice with understanding.
