

Jarunee Aphiwatpisan 2011: Follow-up Study of Graduate from Faculty of Accountancy, Rangsit University. Master of Education (Educational Research and Evaluation), Major Field: Educational Research and Evaluation, Department of Education. Thesis Advisor: Assistant Professor Wasan Thongthai, Ed.D. 160 pages.

The purpose of this research was follow up study the graduates in Accounting Program, Rangsit University in academic year 2007 - 2008 as follow: careers status, characteristic though curriculum objective and desirable professional characteristics of accounting within Thai Qualifications Framework for Higher Education in Bachelor of Accountancy. The target population were graduates and their supervisors. Data were collected by interview and questionnaire using. The content analysis, frequency and percentile were used for analyzing data.

The study results indicated that overall of accounting graduated characteristics was at good level. For each components were found that 1) moral, professional ethics and responsibility characteristics were past 2) accounting knowledge as well as other related and the ability to communicate were past, except wrote and spoke English fluency, in the other hands supervisors indicated that speaking English effectively, financial statements analysis and interpretation of quantitative data were not qualified in supervisors' opinion 3) vision, creativity, pursuit of knowledge and interesting to study in a higher level were past, except monitoring changes related to accounting though graduates' opinion, moreover supervisors indicated that graduates' attention for studying in the higher level was not past, too.
