

Kaltera Sookkum 2011: Family Function, Moral Quotient and Good Citizenship of Senior Students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus. Master of Science (Community Psychology), Major Field: Community Psychology, Department of Psychology. Thesis Advisor: Assistant Professor Tippavan Surinya, Ph.D. 156 pages.

The objectives of this study were 1) to study family function, moral quotient and good citizenship of Senior students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus. 2) to compare good citizenship of Senior students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus according to their personal factors. 3) to study the relationship between family function and good citizenship of Senior students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus. 4) to study the relationship between moral quotient and good citizenship of Senior students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus. 5) to study the relationship between family function and moral quotient of Senior students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus.

The sample were 366 of Senior students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus selected by stratified random sampling. The instrument was the questionnaire. Data were analyzed by using percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, F-test multiple comparison by LSD and Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient. The level of statistical significance was set at lower 0.05.

The result of the study revealed as follows: 1) Family function of Senior students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus was at moderate level. Moral quotient was at high level and good citizenship was also at high level. The Senior students at Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus with differences in sex and grade point average had differences in good citizenship at 0.001 and 0.05 level of statistical significance. 3) Family function had positively correlated to good citizenship at 0.001 level of statistical significance. 4) Moral quotient had positively correlated to good citizenship at 0.001 level of statistical significance. 5) Family function had positively correlated to moral quotient at 0.001 level of statistical significance.
