

(2) Voters with different economic and social backgrounds tend to have a similar decision in election process.

This research is confined to the 14th general election held on July 27, 1986 in the sub-district of Du-lad, Sai-Mun district, Yasothon province. The findings was based on interviews 182 samples and some officials supervising the election. In addition, observation on the interviews, previous experience on the conducting of election in the area and the study of related data were also done.

The results of the research can be summarized as follows: (1) The majority of voters, 80 percent, followed the four steps of election process; and (2) Voters with different economic and social backgrounds have a similar decision on election process.
