From the study, it shows that the growth of technology , economic and efficiency of commercial management of private sector trigger the state to change the existing economic policy in order to develop same to catch up with today's business world, therefore the privatisation process has been applied for by expecting that it should solve problems which occur to the State Enterprises and improve the quality of products and services to benefit people according to the principle of public service and allow people to participate in managing the State Enterprises by raising from the public. As for the above mentioned reasons, it necessary to have the privatisation law in order to clearly determine roles and duties of persons acting according to the privatisation process. In other countries, there are different procedures for privatisation i.e. 1. by specifying a specific law which determines full roles, responsibilities and duties way calling as the privatisation law 2. by amending the existing law on the establishment of each enterprises. In Thailand, the privatisation policy has developed for some times but the legal process to support the privatisation is unclear and inappropriate i.e. the privatisation cannot be applied in an efficiency way.

Therefore, this thesis is aimed to research in the legal process of privatisation in Thailand and other countries which has already been developed before in order to improve same to be suitable for Thailand.
