This research is aimed studying not only cause, pattern and pocess of protest by local
people against government agency but also their bargain with government officials and response of
the agency to the protest.

Protest in rural areas is here hypothesized to result from people's dissatisfaction over
unfair treatment by personal of government agency and their demand for its immediate removal. A
success of any protest demands mainly on such factor as resource mobilization, group relationship,
group organization, intragroup relationship and alliance.

It is found in the case of Nongsaeng District that the unfair treatments by government
officials and the conflicts over local interests are the main causes of its people's protest. To pressure
government agencies to respond to their demand, protest groups in the district rely on not merely
their own resource mobilization and organization but the supports from some groups of sympathizers
as well.
