

**Term Paper Title:** Success in Criminal Suppression Performed by Police Officers of the Inspection Unit under Muang Phetchaburi Police Station **Author:** Pol.Snr.Sgt.Maj. Adul Praitmanee **Major:** Urban and Rural Community Development and Administration **Year:** 2010

### **Abstract**

The purposes of this study were: 1) to determine success in criminal suppression performed by police officers of the inspection unit under Muang Phetchaburi police station; 2) to examine the criminal suppression operated by police officers of the inspection unit under Muang Phetchaburi police station; and 3) to examine operation in solving problems concerning with the criminal suppression made by the police officers of the inspection unit. The samples were 125 police officers of the inspection unit under Muang Phetchaburi police station randomly drawn with a Taro Yamane's formula. The data were collected by using a questionnaire, and then analyzed with statistical methods to determine percentage, mean, and standard deviation. The research hypothesis was tested with t-test, one-way ANOVA, and LSD match-pair analysis.

The study revealed that:

1. The success in criminal suppression performed by the police officers of the inspection unit under Muang Phetchaburi police station on the whole was at a high level; ranging from the higher mean score as the aspect of life and property safety protection, drug suppression, and security of living respectively.

2. The operation of criminal suppression performed by the police officers of the inspection unit under Muang Phetchaburi police station on the whole was at a moderate level; ranging from the higher mean score in terms of administration and management, vehicle and transportation, and budgeting respectively.

3. The operation in solving problems concerning with the criminal suppression made by the police officers of the inspection unit on the whole was at a moderate level; ranging for higher mean score as the aspect of operating personnel, administration and commanding, and social welfare and benefits for the police officers respectively.

4. Difference in age, monthly income, and positional ranks of the police officers did not yield any different opinion towards performance of the criminal suppression on the whole, but difference in educational level and responsible area coverage did yield different opinion towards the success in criminal suppression performed by police officers of the inspection unit under Muang Phetchaburi police station on the whole significantly at 0.05 level.
