

Kewaree Muanruang 2011: An Integrated Instruction Development for Prathomsuksa 5 Students, Suraolakkorn School. Master of Education (Educational Research and Evaluation), Major Field: Educational Research and Evaluation, Department of Education. Thesis Advisor: Assistant Professor Wasun Thongthai, Ed.D. 173 pages.

An action research approach was applied for this study that to develop an integrated instruction and to study the students' learning outcomes. The method for developing an integrated instruction was as follow: 1) curriculum, students, and school context analyzing 2) conducting the learning units by defining theme, learning objective, time, content, learning activity and evaluation method, 3) writing the learning unit and verifying it. The target population were 12 prathomsuksa 5 students, Suraolakkorn School in the first semester, academic year 2553. The research instruments were 1) instrument for instruction: 5 lesson plans and worksheets 2) instrument for collecting data: learning evaluation forms and observation forms. Data was collected for 12 hours by writing the instructional result, teaching log and scoring. Then the researcher was reflect and revise learning activity. Frequency, percentage and content analysis were used for analyzing data.

The results of this study revealed that: the students were good at learning outcomes both ability for knowledge applying and desirable characteristics.
